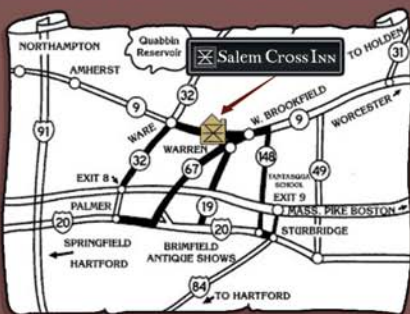
DROVER'S ROAST a 1700's Colonial American Feast Father's Day, Sunday, June 19th and September 11th, 2011
