



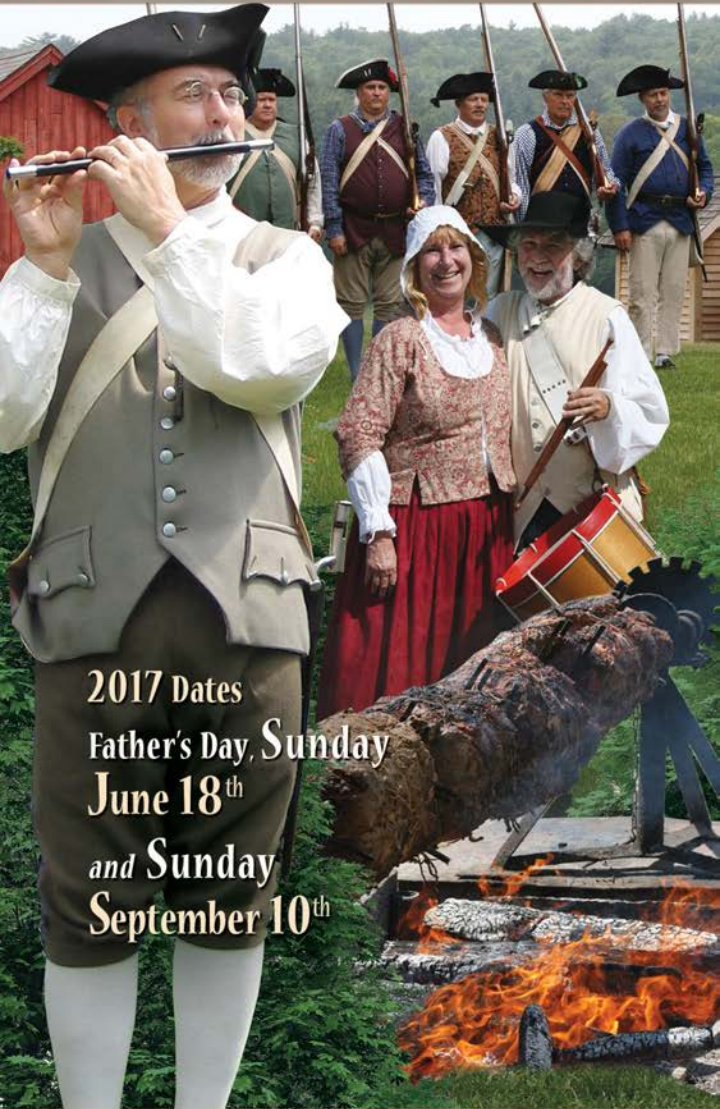

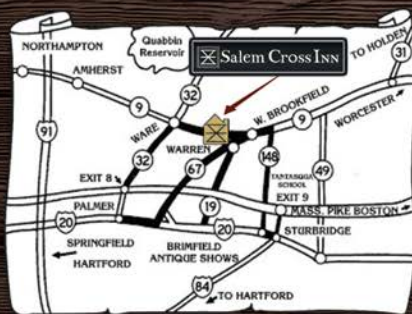


DROVER'S ROAST a 1700's Colonial American Feast
